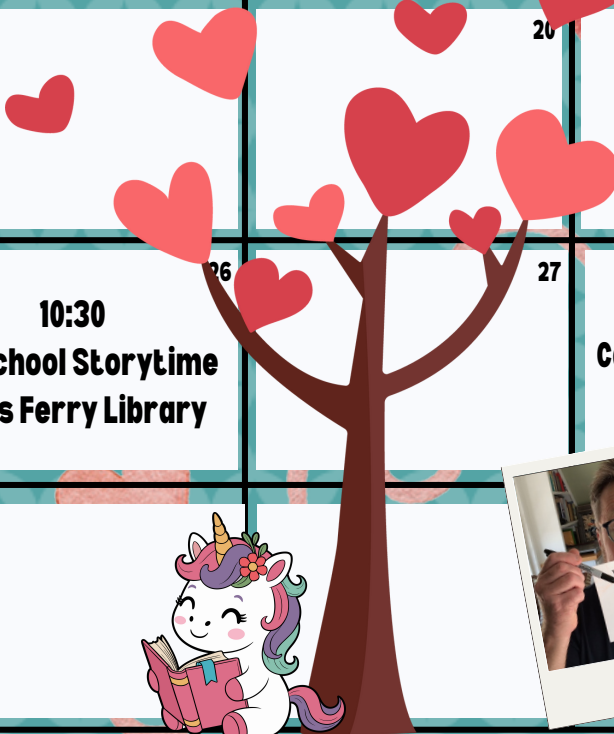

EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

- **Baby Storytime:** Newborns - 18 months and their caregivers to participate in songs, fingerplays, bounces, and more! Drop In at Gales Ferry Library!
- **Giggles and Wiggles:** A fun, active storytime for children ages 18 months - 3 and their caregivers. There will be stories, fingerplays, music, and more! Drop In at Bill Library!
- **Preschool Storytime:** Join us for stories, songs, rhymes, and fun for ages 3 - 5 and their caregivers. Play stations at the end of each storytime actively engage, entertain, and build the skills of the children who participate. Drop In at Gales Ferry Library!
- **Investigators Crafts and Activities:** Drop into the Gales Ferry Library for coloring pages, how to draws, games, puzzles and more featuring your favorite John Patrick Green characters from the InvestiGators graphic novels. For all ages!
- **Spaceship Harmony with Michele Urban:** Catapult your imagination into hyperspace with this new, space-age, interactive music and movement program of faster-than-the-speed-of-light-fun and an out-of-this-world adventure. Michele Urban will lead us in stellar songs, galactically cool games, and rhythm instruments. Blast off in a stretchy rope rocket ship, walk on a parachute moon, shake your moon rocks and defy gravity, dancing with colorful scarves. This is an interactive family style program geared toward the developmental stages of children from 1 to 8 years. For all ages! Drop In!
- **Self Care Journal for Valentine's Day:** Instead of Valentine's Day cards, make a self-care journal filled with encouraging stickers and positive quotes to help you throughout the year! Learn some grounding techniques and emotional regulation skills while building your affirmation journal. Materials, including journals, will be provided. For ages 11 - 18 and registration required.
- **Rockin' Tots:** Explore movement, rhythm, and music at the Bill Library. For babies through 5-year olds and their caregivers. Drop In!
- **Drop In Lego Club:** A time to come together with other people who love building and creating with Legos. Challenges are offered if participants are interested, but the goal of this program is to have fun and be creative with friends. For ages 5 - 12.
- **Craft with Clay - Coil Pots:** Learn the basics of working with air-dry clay! This week: coil pots! Make a fun piece of art with your hands and learn about ceramic techniques! Ages 11 - 18 and registration is required. All materials will be provided.
- **Pokémon Club:** Battle your friends, show off your card collection, enjoy themed crafts and discuss all things Pokémon! At Gales Ferry Library for ages 5 - 18. Drop In!
- **Reading with Dune:** Drop in at Bill Library to read and spend some time with Dune. Available to the first 12 families and each family will have 5 minutes with Dune. Dune is a therapy dog who frequently visits libraries and schools in the area. Dune's handler, Lauren Rugh, is a veterinary technician and she and Dune are Ledyard residents. For all ages!
- **Cartooning Workshop with Rick Stromoski:** Learn to draw cartoons from a pro! Rick Stromoski is the author of the popular book Schnozzer & Tatertoes: Take a Hike! He is also an award-winning cartoonist and humorous illustrator and he is back at Bill Library by popular demand! He will teach participants how to create their own cartoon characters, draw facial expressions, and more!
